


INVITATION to the THEATRE DES VARIETES

"The School of Women" (original title: "L'école des femmes") is a comedy in verse written by the French poet Molière. The first performance took place on December 26, 1662 in Paris. The play is considered Molière's first masterpiece and was the birth of the great classical theater on the foundations of farce.

At the center of the comedy is Arnolphe, who decides to marry his adopted child Agnès. In order to find in the young Agnès a faithful wife, he has kept away from her everything that could have led to her heart-building and the development of her own personality. Arnolphe worries about smart women as many people around the world still do today ... Molière always stays up to date."
