Dear members

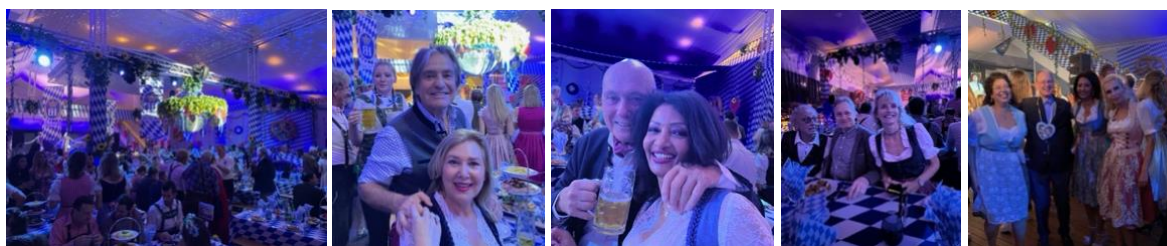
First of all, we send you our best wishes for the new year 2023 which has just begun and during which we will celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of our German International Club of Monaco.

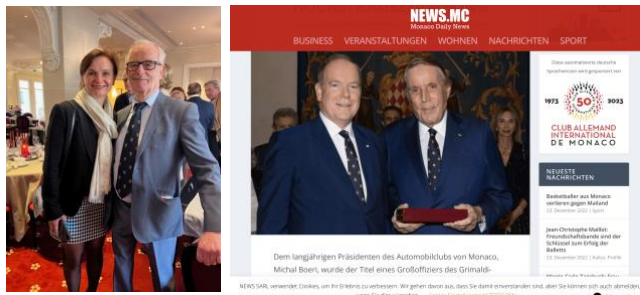


PROMOTION OF THE GERMAN LANGUAGE

News MC in German

Thus, residents of Monaco can for the first time follow daily news from Monaco and the region in the language of Goethe.



Christmas cookies for students studying German

We were interested to know how many pupils were currently learning German in schools in Monaco. After a small survey of German teachers, we identified more than 150 students and decided, as part of the Club's upcoming fiftieth anniversary, to offer each of them Christmas cookies. These were directly imported from Munich, from the famous confectionery Kreuzkamm. This initiative has thus enabled us to establish additional contact with all students learning German and their families.
