Our next Club trip takes us to Vienna, the capital of Austria, but also the former capital of the Habsburg Empire. Vienna is a city full of charm and contrasts, with its imposing imperial buildings and castles, its opera, but also with its popular districts such as Grinzing. The music is also very present there and the cuisine is very well-known. We have put together a very nice program that will allow you to discover classic Vienna, but also new aspects and places that you may not have visited before.

Arrival and departure

The journey to Vienna is individual. For those of you departing from Nice, there are currently two possible connections. Many other connections exist from Frankfurt, Munich, Berlin or Zurich.

Program

Wednesday, 28 May: St. Stephen's Cathedral and Heuringen

Wednesday is your arrival day.



The program officially starts around 3 p.m., (exact time to be confirmed) where we meet in the bar of the hotel. Afterwards, we explore the surroundings of the hotel as part of a guided tour and visit the famous St. Stephen's Cathedral, a landmark of the city and the resting place of many Habsburg emperors. Here we have organized a private and exclusive tour, including the roof terrace and the crypt.

In the evening we will take the historic Heuriger Express to Grinzing, a famous district of relaxation and conviviality, and taste local wine and traditional Viennese cuisine in the restaurant "10er Marie".

Thursday, May 29: Day trip around Vienna, with a visit to the Prater and Schönbrunn Palace

On Thursday we go on a full-day excursion to discover Vienna and its surroundings. We first cross the Ring, then the UN Quarter and finally we take a break in the big wheel of the Prater.



We will then continue to Schönbrunn Palace, the spectacular summer palace of the Habsburgs, where we will take a private guided tour, including a visit to the Bergl Rooms, specially designed for Empress Maria Theresa, as well as the beautiful gardens.



Back and after a break at the hotel, we will have dinner at the famous and traditional restaurant "Zum Schwarzen Kameel".



Friday, 30 May: Purveyors to the Court and Opera

On Friday, we will visit various historic manufactories of Viennese families who worked as suppliers to the imperial court. In particular, we will visit the factory of our member Jean Paul Vaugoin, who still produces and sells exclusive silverware. In addition, the workshops of a tailor, a jeweller and a glassmaker.



At noon, we are invited by the Honorary Consul of Monaco in Vienna, Christian Dorda, to a finger food lunch in his office, with a beautiful view over the Ring. Afterwards, the afternoon is at your disposal.

In the evening we will go to the State Opera to see the famous Verdi opera "II Trovatore". Thanks to our member Norbert Schaller, we are trying to reserve the Imperial Box and the Tee Salon for us privately, where we have also organized a champagne reception, dinner and an introduction to the opera from 6 p.m. onwards.



Saturday, May 31st: The Liechtensteins in Vienna

On Saturday morning, a private tour of the city palace of the Princely Liechtenstein family awaits us. We will discover the impressive collections of the Prince of Liechtenstein - one of the most important private collections in the world, which has grown over centuries.



After lunch, we have the opportunity to visit the treasures of the Habsburgs in the Kunsthistorisches Museum, as well as in the Treasury Chamber, or to take part in a tour of the works of the famous architect Otto Wagner.



At the end of the visits, we meet at Café Central to enjoy the traditional Viennese coffee house culture.

In the evening, we can look forward to a festive gala dinner in the Marble Hall of the Hotel Sacher, to which we have been invited thanks to our member Daniel Hersche from LGT Private Banking - the private bank of the Princely House of Liechtenstein. The evening will be enriched by the music of young talented musicians from the "LGT Young Soloists".



Sunday 1 June: a farewell round

On Sunday morning we take a last tour of Vienna and visit the spectacular Court Library.



With lunch together in the restaurant of the Hotel Rosewood we officially end our trip. After that, everyone is free to start their return journey to Nice or another destination.
